The Sacraments

1. Is there anything in your life that acts as a reminder of your salvation (e.g., song, person, practice)?
2. What is your understanding of the Lord's Supper and Baptism? How do they act as reminders to you?
3. In Romans 6:4, Paul says, "We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life." Have you been baptized? If yes, what did it mean to you, and why did you do it? If no, why not?
4. Read 1 Corinthians 11:23-26. What do you notice? How does the Passover enrich your understanding of Jesus' work and our observance of Communion?
5. How do the sacraments point you Christ, bring unity to the church, and/or affect how you live? What do they tell you about the sacredness of creation and the ways God chooses to make Himself and His grace known to us?
