Second Chances

WORSHIP

Read Psalm 30 aloud. Take a moment to reflect on God's Word and center in Him.

FELLOWSHIP

-When were you most aware of God this past week?

-How did everyone live out last week's sermon and discussion? Has anyone found or been praying for a mentor (or mentee)?

DISCUSSION

Watch this [sermon summary video](#). Discuss the questions below, or if you're studying a book, RightNow Media series, etc., transition to discussion and try to include questions that address head, heart, and hands.

1. Have you ever given or received a second chance?

2. Read Joshua 1:1-9.

-What does this passage tell us about God?

-What instruction does God offer Joshua and Israel for this reset moment?

-What is one thing you can take to heart as you face your own reset moment?

3. What have you learned during this season of crisis? What is one way you have grown?

4. 1 John 1:9 says, "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness."

-What does this verse tell us about the reset we are offered in Christ?

-Is there something you need to confess to God this week? Or is there a person you need to forgive and offer a second chance, in light of the forgiveness you've received from God?

PRAYER

Ask for prayer requests; try to remember any needs that came up during the fellowship or discussion time. Check in on requests from last week, if you can. Does anyone have a practical need that another group member may be able to help with?

Pray for group, church, and community needs. Consider reading Psalm 51 together as a prayer of confession, and thank God for His abundant mercy.
