

Lighthouse Updated Health and Safety Procedures

Please note the schedule for Lighthouse Kids programming:

October: Kids will attend the service with their parents and will be dismissed after worship time to their Lighthouse groups.

November: Regular Lighthouse programs resume. Kids will join their groups for the entire service.

Volunteer Screening

- Before entering the children's areas, volunteers will be asked to answer screening questions regarding symptoms and contact with anyone testing positive for COVID.
- Volunteers will have their temperature checked each Sunday morning.

Check In

- Parents are asked to check in their children at the fast pass kiosk when they arrive on Sunday morning. This is requested even if the children will be attending the service in the sanctuary with their parents.
- Only designated volunteers will be entering information on the ipad screen.

Drop off and Pick Up

- Our new routines for drop-off and pick-up are designed to ensure everyone stays healthy and safe. There will be procedures specific to each campus so families should follow directions posted as each campus.
- During pick up/drop off, we ask that everyone practice social distancing.
- As always, Fast Pass stickers will be matched to the child's name tag to authorize pick up.

Classrooms

- **Classroom cleanliness.** Toys, craft materials, and other high-touch surfaces will be routinely disinfected and rotated. We will pause the use of play dough, stuffed animals, and other materials that are difficult to clean.
- **Social distancing.** We'll continue to practice social distancing as much as possible to reduce risk. Please look for signage and floor markers to maintain your distance at drop-off and pick-up.
- **Snacks.** We will not be serving any food for a snack during the Sunday morning service.

Keeping Areas Clean

- All high-touch surfaces and objects will be sanitized regularly. These include, but are not limited to, arts and crafts materials, toys, light switches and door handles.

Face Coverings

- **Masks for adults:** All volunteers are required to wear masks. We ask that all adults wear a mask during drop-off and pick-up.
- **Masks for kids:** Children ages 3 and up are required to wear face masks. (If a child is unable to wear a mask, parents can meet with campus Lighthouse director to come up with a safe solution.)

What should I do if my child is sick or a family member has been diagnosed with covid-19?

For the safety of children and families at Christ Church Crossroads, anyone who is ill must stay home. If you or a loved one has been diagnosed with COVID-19, immediately alert the church office and stay home. Please follow the CDC's recommendations if you're unwell or if you have been diagnosed with COVID-19.
