WORSHIP

Read Isaiah 43:1-2,10-13 aloud. Take a moment to reflect on God's Word and center in Him.

FELLOWSHIP

How did living out last week's discussion go? How did you carry the "aroma of Christ" into your home, neighborhood, social media, and/or workplace?

DISCUSSION

Watch this sermon overview video to refresh your group on this week's message. Then discuss the questions below. If you're studying a book, RightNow Media series, etc., transition to discussion and try to include questions that address head, heart, and hands.

1. If you were to describe Jesus to someone who didn't know Him, what would you say?

-How has your understanding of Jesus changed over the years?

-Do you believe you've met "the real Jesus"? Why or why not?

2. Read Revelation 1:9-20.

-How is Jesus described here?

-Which details are challenging or confusing to you? Which give you hope or move you to worship?

-Have you ever had an experience of seeing or hearing Jesus, or of being overwhelmed by His glory (v. 17)?

3. Respond to Pastor Mike's argument that "the Christian life does not make any sense if you are not living in light of forever."

-What is your primary focus?

-Does anything keep you from focusing on Jesus and "living in light of forever"?

-How does an eternal, Jesus-focused perspective affect your view of current events?

4. How would it look for you to worship at the feet of the real Jesus? Is there something you can do this week to help you focus on Him?

PRAYER

Ask for prayer requests; try to remember any needs that came up during the fellowship or discussion time. Check in on requests from last week, if you can. Does anyone have a practical need that another group member may be able to help with?

Pray for group, church, and community needs. Have the leader close by praying Ephesians 1:17-23 over the group.
