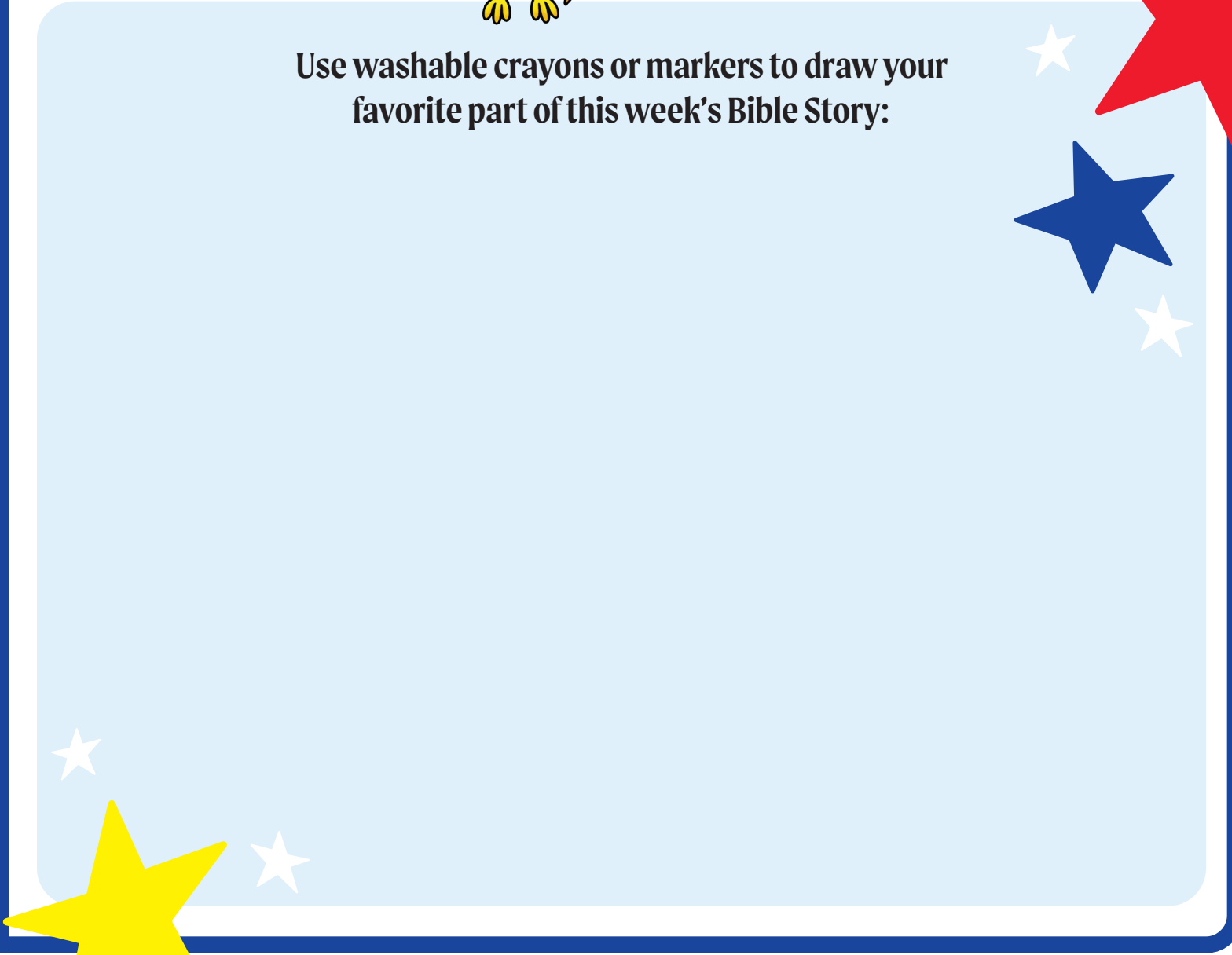

WEEK 1

1 Samuel 16:6-13

Why was David chosen to be king?
(He loved God.)

Who has big things for you to do? (God)

WEEK 2

David trusts that God is with him, and has the strength and courage to protect the sheep from a lion.

1 Samuel 17:34-37

Where was David when God was with him?
(In the field)

Where can God help you do big things?
(Anywhere)

WEEK 3

David battles Goliath with only a sling and a stone when King Saul and his army are too afraid.

1 Samuel 17:1-50

Who was not afraid to battle the giant? (David)
Who was with David when he battled the giant?
(God)

WEEK 4

King David helps Jonathan's son, Mephibosheth, and shows kindness to Jonathan's family.

1 Samuel 20:14-17; 2 Samuel 9:1-13

Who gave land and food to Mephibosheth?
(King David)

Who made you to help? (God)

WEEK 5

King David praises God to say, "Thank You!"

2 Samuel 6:12-15

Why can you be strong and courageous?
(God is always with me.)

Who can praise God? (Everyone)
