DISCUSSION

1. Read Romans 12:9-13.

- a. Which of these instructions stands out to you?*
- b. In what ways does Jesus model and enable us to live out this passage?*
- c. How does your small group love as this passage describes? What might you ask for God's help to grow in, whether individually or as a group?*

2. What does it mean to be "joyful in hope" (v. 12)?

- a. How is joy possible when life is hard?*
- b. What promises of God bring you hope?*

Christian ethicist Christine Pohl writes, "Some of us operate with a well-developed sense of entitlement, quite certain that we deserve good things and are entitled to the best that 'life' has to offer. Others of us, because we work hard, are convinced that we have earned the good that has come to us."¹

- c. What are some other things that might deplete joy or inhibit growth in gratitude?*
