## WORSHIP

Read Hebrew 10:19-25 aloud. Take a moment to reflect on God's Word and center in Him.

## FELLOWSHIP

## DISCUSSION

1. Do you expect life to be easy? Why or why not?
2. Read 2 Peter 1:5-15.
  - a. *What stands out to you in this passage today?*
  - b. *What instructions does Peter offer?*
  - c. *What do you need to be reminded of?*
  - d. *How might it look to "refresh [the] memory" of others using the qualities listed in verses 5-7?*
  - d. *How do verses 1-4 enrich your understanding of this passage?*
3. Pastor Mike suggested that we all need "a more ravishing vision of who God is."
  - a. *How can you grow and deepen your understanding of God?*
  - b. *What is one aspect of God's character that is captivating to you?*
  - c. *How might a greater understanding of God affect how you live?*
4. Where is God touching your life through this passage or our discussion?
5. How will you live out what you're learning this week?

Ask for prayer requests; try to remember any needs that came up during the fellowship or discussion time. Check in on requests from last week, if you can. Does anyone have a practical need that another group member may be able to help with?
