

# JESUS THE LOGOS

JOHN 1:1-18

## WORSHIP

Begin by reading and meditating on Psalm 95:1-7.

## FELLOWSHIP

What is something you're proud to have created?

## DISCUSSION

1. Read John 1:1-13 slowly aloud two times, inviting people to notice what stands out in these verses.

Ask: What did you notice? What stood out to you? Give each person an opportunity to share..

2. Jesus identified in this passage as the Word and the Light.

*a. What things does it say about the light?*

*b. What is significant about the light for the way you see the world? For the way you see yourself?*

3. Read John 1:14-18 slowly aloud two times, inviting people to notice what stands out in these verses.

Ask again: What did you notice? What stood out to you? Give each person an opportunity to share.

4. Jesus is identified here as the Word made flesh, living among us.

*a. What are the key aspects of his glory?*

*b. Why are grace and truth important?*

*c. How did Jesus display both grace and truth in his early life?*

*d. In what ways do you need to receive his grace and truth? In what ways can you display it?*

## PRAYER

Below is an excerpt from the Book of Common Prayer. In light of the Russian invasion of Ukraine, spend some time in prayer for peace that flows from the truth of Jesus.

*Almighty God our heavenly Father, guide the nations of the world into the way of justice and truth, and establish among them that peace which is the fruit of righteousness, that they may become the kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Amen.*
