DISCUSSION

John 13:31-38

- 1. Mike states that Jesus glory on earth is radically different than the glory we think of for other kings and rulers in our time. When Jesus talks about himself about to be glorified in vs. 31 what is he referring to?
- 2. Jesus states that he gives a new command: to love one another. Why does he give this command? (vs. 35) What difference would this make in our world? What ways do you think we get this wrong?
- 3. How does Peter respond to this command? (vs. 36) Why do you think Peter responded this way? What do you think he misunderstood about Jesus purpose on earth?
- 4. What does Jesus reveal about what would ultimately happen to Peter? (vs. 38) How does Peter's inability to lay down his life for Jesus' life demonstrate the significance of Jesus love for us?
- 5. Since Jesus has not called us give our life for his, but rather he has given his life for ours, what does he ask of us? (vs. 35)
