DISCUSSION

John 14:15-31

- 1. Who is the advocate that Jesus is referring to? (vs. 15) What purpose does the advocate serve?
- 2. Jesus tells the disciples that the world will no longer see him but that the disciples will (vs. 19). Judas (not Judas Iscariot) questions the purpose of this plan (vs. 22). How does Jesus respond? (vs. 23) Do you think this answer gives Judas clarity? Why or why not?
- 3. How does Jesus explanation of the advocate, the Holy Spirit, help us understand how we and others can still see and believe in Jesus? (vs. 26)
- 4. How does Jesus want them respond to this information that he must go away? (vs. 28) What purpose does he tell them this information? (vs. 29)
- 5. Jesus final statement in vs. 31 is that he has done exactly what the Father has commanded him. By keeping Gods commands what does that show? (vs. 21) As a result who do we see? (vs. 21)
