INTRO

DISCUSSION

READ: Numbers 13:26-33; Joshua 14:6-11

- 1. After spying out the land as a group Caleb has a very different view of what should be done than the others (Num. 13:30-31). Why do you think Caleb takes this unpopular position?
- 2. Joshua 14:10 we see Caleb explaining why he has survived the 40 years in the wilderness whereas the previous generation had all died. How does he view himself (vs. 11)? Why do you think he thinks of himself as such?
- 3. What land does Caleb ask for (Josh. 14:12)? Who does he say will give him help (vs. 12)?
- 4. Joshua 14:14 shares the epilogue of this story. What can we learn from Caleb in how he lived?
