INTRO

Talk about the time in your life when being tasked with making a decision brought you the most angst (a job, a relationship, a choice between two good things). How did you decide and what happened?

DISCUSSION

READ: Exodus 28:15-30

- 1. Pastor Mike spent the bulk of his time discussing the question of how we are to understand God's will, based on the Urim and the Thummim found in Exodus 28:30. He said that, while it may not have specific counsel on every issue, the Bible contains most of what we need to know to live well. Do you agree? How have you seen that play out in your life?
- 2. Mike suggests 4 ways God guides: his word, the Holy Spirit, our mind, and other people. Do you agree or disagree with this list? Which one do you feel guides you the most?
- 3. Do you feel like a need for an answer from God drives you to Him? Has that been helpful? Talk about a time when you have sought God's will more than God, and the other way around. Or a time when you thought you heard God's voice…and it didn't work out.
- 4. What do you make of Augustine's quote: "Love God, and do as you please." Is that helpful? Confusing? Why?
