Colossians 1:24-2:7

DISCUSSION

- 1. Syler mentions Paul's perspective on suffering for Christ. How have you experienced or witnessed suffering as a Christian? In what ways can suffering deepen our faith or witness to others?
- 2. Paul refers to Christ as a "mystery" that has been revealed. How would you explain this concept to someone unfamiliar with Christianity? What does it mean to you personally that Christ is "in you, the hope of glory"?
- 3. The sermon emphasizes the importance of being "rooted" in faith, not just making a one-time decision. What practices or habits have helped you stay rooted in your faith over time? What challenges have you faced in maintaining a deep-rooted faith?
- 4. Syler mentions the need for both individual soul care and community involvement. On a scale of 1-10, how would you rate your current soul care (vertical)? How about your community commitment (horizontal)?
- 5. Reflecting on the cypress trees analogy, what "streams of water" nourish your faith? How can we as a group help each other grow strong and resilient in our faith, like those hundred-foot trees?
