Psalm 90:10-17

## INTRO

Do you have a memory of the first time you learned about death? Perhaps as a child? If you feel comfortable, please share with the group.

## DISCUSSION

- 1. Psalm 90:12 says, "Teach us to number our days, that we may gain a heart of wisdom." What do you think it means to "number our days"? How might this practice lead to wisdom in our lives?
- 2. The psalm ends with a prayer for God's favor and the establishment of our work (verses 16-17). How does the reality of our mortality influence the way we view our daily work and long-term goals? In light of this psalm, how might we approach our life differently?
- 3. Mike mentions that our culture often avoids discussing death. Why do you think that is? How has this cultural attitude shaped your own views on mortality?
- 4. For those who believe in Christ, how does the promise of eternal life impact your view of death? Does it remove all fear, or not really?
- 5. How might a deeper awareness of death's reality help us appreciate the power and relevance of Jesus' promises in our daily lives?
- 6. What practical steps can you take now to prepare for your own death?
